The search is on for the exact date of George Tramountanas' arrival in Port Adelaide in 1842 and the date he left Greece and from which port. We also need the name of the ship that George undertook his voyage on. If you have this information and can verify it with a source, the Tramountanas-North Association Inc would like to hear from you.

We also need to find the eldest living descendants of Hero & Rosina North and also George & Eliza North.

In preparation for the restoration of their gravesites, we need to process some paperwork with the South Australian Cemeteries Authority, which must be signed by the eldest living descendants.

We have to go through this process because we do not have the original plot lease certificates for these gravesites. With the passage of time, the certificates have fallen out of possession of the families and cannot be re-printed by the S.A.C.A
